Question 1: How is Susie feeling?

- a. Hateful
- b. Annoyed – CORRECT: She says dogs are ‘sometimes annoying’ as she complains about her husky.
- c. Confused
- d. Awful

Question 2: How would you describe Suzie?

- a. A dog hater
- b. A dog whisperer
- c. A dog therapist
- d. A dog owner – CORRECT: She owns a husky that has been obnoxiously loud lately. Option A is incorrect because she is offended that her friend thinks she sounds like a dog hater.

Question 3: Using context, what can we infer about a dog whisperer’s job?

- a. They talk quietly to loud dogs.
- b. They train misbehaved dogs. – CORRECT: ‘She can take your dog’s obnoxiousness and turn it 360,’ meaning change their bad behavior.
- c. They impound dogs from unfit owners.

- d. They take in stray dogs.

Question 4: How does Susie feel about sending her dog to the dog whisperer?

- a. Apprehensive – CORRECT: At the end of their conversation, she hesitates to agree on sending her dog.
- b. Confident
- c. Frustrated
- d. Joyful

- a. They had a misbehaved dog themselves.
- b. They are good friends with her.
- c. They heard about it through her husband. – CORRECT: The friend says, 'Her husband told me these things about her'.
