- 1. Which city does the gentleman live in?
- a. Winnipeg
- b. Somewhere in the US
- c. Calgary CORRECT: The gentleman mentioned how housing pricing in Calgary was similar to Winnipeg by saying "We have the same advantage here in Calgary"
- d. Toronto
- 2. What do Kelly and the gentleman think about Nancy?
- a. They think their cities are better
- b. They are in argument with her
- c. They think her opinions are wrong
- d. They think she is a show off CORRECT: Kelly first expressed how she was annoyed with Nancy praising Toronto and the gentleman later agreed with Kelly. Option B would be incorrect since it seems like a friendly banter (with everyone smiling) rather than a serious argument.
- 3. Why does Kelly mention the million dollar mortgage?
- a. To annoy Nancy

- b. She is expressing sarcasm CORRECT: Kelly was annoyed how Nancy kept praising Toronto. She fired back by criticizing Toronto's high mortgage prices as a way to criticize Toronto and downplay the praises mentioned by Nancy.
- c. She wants to talk about mortgages instead of Winnipeg's weather
- d. She is trying to make a joke
- 4. How would you describe Nancy?
- a. An unapologetic show off
- b. Probably a shopping enthusiast CORRECT. Nancy mentioned how smaller cities have less shopping malls implying she considers that to be an important area of her life. Option A is subjective. Some might consider her a show off, some might consider her too honest, or some might consider her simply talkative. It is not a surety that her behaviour is representative of a show off.
- c. Very friendly
- d. Very practical
- 5. Who would most likely move from their current city?
- a. The gentleman
- b. Nancy
- c. Kelly
- d. There is not enough information CORRECT: Kelly is unhappy with the weather while the gentleman admires the US more. They are likely candidates but none of them ended up saying they would actually move.

## 6. What is Nancy's attitude towards smaller cities?

- a. Condescending CORRECT: This option is very close to Option D. However, if you factor in the tone that Nancy uses, especially in this sentence, "Less things to do, less jobs, less shopping outlets. And did we cover the weather already? Yea that's as bad as it gets" we can see that she was not objectively criticizing the smaller cities but that she was purposefully making an attempt to condescend smaller cities.

- 7. What makes Kelly proud to live in Winnipeg?
- a. The mortgage rates CORRECT: Option D is very close as Kelly mentioned at the end how the weather had made her stronger, however, she also started the conversation by saying how she hated the weather; hence, it's not a safe choice. She did criticize Toronto's mortgage rates compared to Winnipeg which shows she is proud of her city's low prices.
- b. Nothing
- c. Less crowds
- d. Cold weather
- 8. What does the gentleman mean by 'agitated' in the following sentence 'You know what Nancy. I can see why Kelly gets agitated whenever you sing praises about Toronto'?

a. uneasy - CORRECT: It is the literal definition of 'agitated' and other options do not fit Kelly's mood.
